Hamilton Resources, Ltd. is a Junior Exploration company engaged in the acquisition, exploration, and potential development of precious minerals properties in Peru.

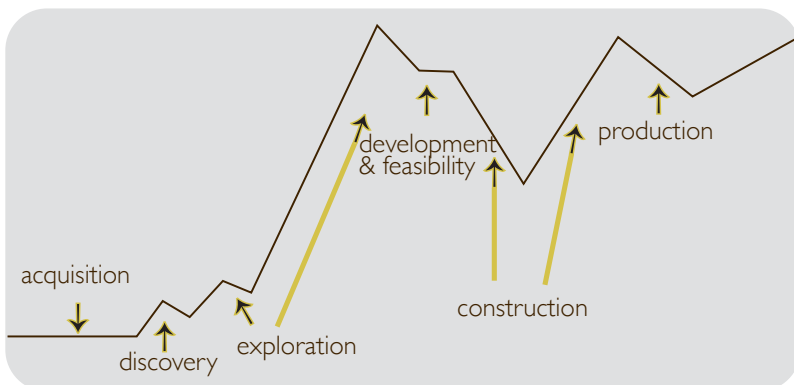
Hamilton Resources, Ltd. was incorporated in October 2012 and seed funding was completed. Planned capitalization is \$5,000,000 which represents 33% of Hamilton Resources, Ltd. The company has completed the acquisition of twelve concessions which comprise five projects in the north-west sector of Peru.

Why Peru?

Peru has a long standing tradition of being friendly to the mining industry, and it's easy to understand why:

- Peru is one of the six richest mineral countries in the world.
- 38% of the country's GDP is attributable to this industry.
- Several of the world's largest mineral deposits have been found in Peru.
- In 2012, Peru was the world's top silver producer, the second-largest producer of zinc and copper, and the world's sixth-largest gold producer.
- Peru is the leading producer of gold silver, zinc, and On in Latin America.
- In 2012 mining exports represented 62% of the country's overall exports.

Mineral exploration companies often follow a specific life cycle as illustrated by this chart. Hamilton Resources, Ltd. is preparing to start their exploration period.

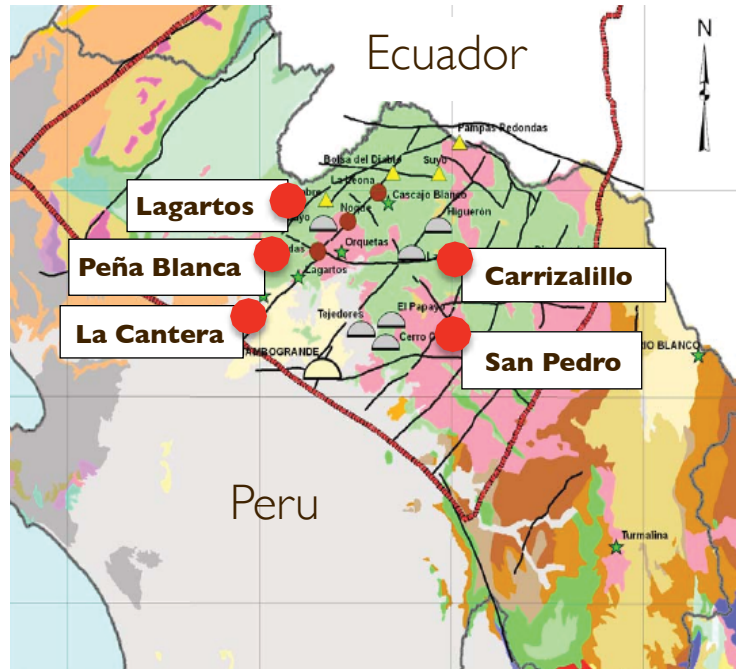
The greatest return on capital is achieved in the exploration phase.

Why Hamilton Resources, Ltd?

Julian Rosero - CEO, a native Ecuadorian, provides RHR Inc. with over thirty years of experience in field exploration and mining evaluation of placer gold and other mineral deposits. Prior to joining RHR Inc., he worked extensively in a number of projects within Ecuador evaluating and managing field exploration operations involving placer and hard rock mineral deposits. He has served as the Director of the Ecuadorian Geological Survey and as the Vice Minister of the Ecuadorian Ministry of Mines. He is a graduate of the Central University of Ecuador with a degree in mining engineering and has completed post-graduate work in mining geology at Leicester University in England.



Mr. Rosero has taught mineralogy and mineral exploration, and he has authored a book entitled "Mineralogenic Zoning of Ecuador". Mr. Rosero resides in Quito, Ecuador where RHR Inc. has established its Ecuadorian project office.

John Bolanos - President, a co-founder of Hamilton Resources, Ltd., is a mining professional guiding the Peruvian team. He has been a key participant in numerous mineral projects that were funded via public transactions. Mr Bolanos is a "Qualified Person" as defined under National Instruments 43--101 and is also one of three South American geologists who are members of the Society of Mining Engineers. Mr. Bolanos has used his network of technical people in Peru and elsewhere to identify 5 gold and copper prospects in Northern Peru.



We plan to advance exploration on each project during the next six months and determine which holds the best potential to be the company's project of merit as it moves towards a public stock offering or buyout. Preliminary technical reports have already been prepared which include a significant amount of new assays completed in July 2013. Proceeds from this offering will be used to complete a National Instruments 43--101 Technical Report which will aid the company in going public, or validating its value in connection with a sale to a major mining company.
